# Technical Bulletin Connect Your Visualint VI-7000 to a Luma x10 NVR



The Visualint VI-7000 PTZ camera can be used with existing Luma x10 NVRs.

#### Advantages:

- The Luma x10 NVR has Visualint protocol, which allows for smart events
- Image Settings are available in the x10 NVR
- OSD Settings are available in the x10 NVR


### Disadvantages:

- Privacy Mask is not available
- Rules cannot be set up in the x10 NVR
- Requires Internet Explorer

## **Procedure**

#### Set the Protocol

Set the PTZ camera's Protocol to VISUALINT and set the Management Port to 80.





## Image, OSD, and Privacy Mask Settings


The Display and OSD Settings can be edited via the Luma x10 NVR.

## **Motion Settings**


Motion settings set up is as normal for the Luma x10 NVR.



## Set Up Events in the x10 NVR

Under Smart Motion, click the Enable checkbox and set the schedule per the NVR manual.

Go to the Linkage Method tab, click the Enable checkbox and set the linkage desired.






## Set Up Events in the VI-7000

Under VCA > Scene Set, draw the VCA Rule and check the Valid box.

Under VCA > VCA Schedule, check Arming Enabled. Set the schedule. Set Link Type to Visualint Event.
