Introduction

The Control4 USB WiFi Adapter is a USB 2.0 802.11ac/a/b/g/n WiFi module that provides WiFi network access for Control4 products that do not have built-in WiFi. Control4 recommends that a hardwired network connection be used whenever possible. Sometimes the planned network connection may be faulty or unavailable. In those situations, C4-USBWIFI can be a useful tool to get the job done.

Installing the USB WiFi adapter

To install the adapter:

- 1 Ensure you have one of the compatible products listed above. The Control4 USB WiFi adapter will only work with supported devices.
- 2 Firmly insert the USB WiFi adapter into an open USB port of the supported product.
- 3 If you wish to install the USB WiFi adapter away from the host device (for example, to improve radio performance), you may use a quality USB-A 2.0 male-to-USB-female extension cable.

Configuring the adapter.

To configure the adapter:

- 1 First connect the host device (such as a controller) to Ethernet.
- 2 Using Composer Pro System Manager, connect to the device.
- 3 Select **Configure** and follow the *Network Configuration Wizard* to configure the network settings for the controller.
