



SM-FLAT2-S Strong™ Small Low Profile Flat Mount



Install Guide

Hardware kit



Warnings

- We highly recommend this product be installed by a qualified professional.
- Do not begin installation until you have thoroughly read and understood these instructions.
- This mount supports display mounting from VESA 75×75, 100×100 and up to 200×100 and supports a maximum load of 40 lb (18.2 kg).
- Ensure the wall that you plan to use can safely support four times the combined weight of the mount and display.
- The manufacturer does not accept responsibility for incorrect installation.

Tools required

- Power drill
- 3/16" (5mm) drill bit
- 5/16" (8mm) masonry bit
- Phillips head screwdriver
- 10 mm socket
- Level

Box contents

- Wall plate (×1)
- Adapter plate (×1)
- Hardware kit (×1)



Installation

Mark the mounting hole locations

Use the wall plate to mark the mounting hole locations. The use of a stud finder is highly recommended.


Mounting on a stud wall

- 1. Pre-drill two holes into the center of the stud using a 3/16" drill bit.
- 2. Orient the wall plate so that the arrow is pointing up. Using two lag screws fasten the wall plate to the wall.

Warning: Tighten the screws so that the wall plate is firmly attached, but do not over tighten. Over tightening can damage the screws, greatly reducing their holding strength.

Concrete wall mounting

Pre-drill two holes into the concrete using 5/16" drill bits.
 Insert concrete wall anchors and tap them in with a hammer, if necessary.



Warning: When installing the wall plate on cinder block, verify there is a minimum of 1–3/8" of concrete thickness for the concrete wall anchors. Do not drill into mortar joints!

Be sure to mount in a solid part of the block, at least 1" minimum from the side of the block. Cinder block must meet ASTM C-90 specifications. Use a standard electric drill on a slow setting to drill the hole, instead of a hammer drill, to avoid breaking out the back of the hole when entering a void or cavity.

Concrete must be 2000 psi density minimum. Lighter density concrete may not hold the concrete anchor.

Make sure that the supporting surface can safely support the combined load of the equipment and all of the attached hardware and components.


2. Orient the wall plate so that the arrow is pointing up. Using two lag screws, fasten the wall plate to the wall.

Warning: Tighten the screws so that the wall plate is firmly attached, but do not over tighten. Over tightening can damage the screws, greatly reducing their holding strength.




Attach the adapter plate to the display

Attach the adapter plate to the display using M4, M5, or M6 screws. For displays with a hole pattern in a pocket or inputs behind the adapter plate, spacers go between the adapter plate and display.



Attach the adapter plate and display to the wall plate

- 1. Attach the adapter plate's top hook onto the wall plate's top hook.
- 2. While pulling down on the pull cord, move the adapter plate's bottom hole into position above the latch and release the pull cord. Ensure that the adapter plate is secured to the wall plate.
