

ACTIVITY ZONES


Points of Interest



Adapting to environments

The Nest Doorbell and Nest Cam are rated IP56 and IP54, respectively, meaning they can hold up to outside elements without you having to worry about damaging them.



Distress calls^{II}

Nest's home awareness devices have natural instincts for identifying specific types of activity. With a paid subscription to Nest Aware, advanced algorithms send more accurate motion and audio alerts at more intelligent times.



Mastering your domain

Google Nest displays and speakers are trained to obey commands and act as translators to your other Nest home awareness devices. To make your voice heard, just wake up your Nest with the phrase, "Hey, Google."
