Important Notes

The firmware will be delivered via over-the-air update directly to Veranda 3 TVs in the field.

Due to the SDDP broadcast stability update, the SDDP binding for Veranda 3 TVs currently in a Control4 project will need to be reinitiated. Partners can re-bind these to the Control4 project remotely. The steps to reinitiate SDDP bindings are listed below, and we will email these steps directly to impacted partners.

Features:

- Support for discrete IR On and Off commands added
- Improved stability of Wi-Fi connectivity during standby
- Improved stability of WakeOn LAN performance when using IP control
- Improved stability of SDDP broadcast
- Control4 port enabled by default for new installations

SDDP Binding Steps

1. Ensure Veranda 3 is powered on.
2. Update Veranda 3 to firmware version 1.0.11 (M0722).
3. In Composer, navigate to **Connections > Network**.
4. In "Available Devices", locate the SunBrite "SBTV-xxxxxx".
5. Click and drag the SDDP broadcast to Veranda 3 display in the **IP Network Connections** section.
6. Navigate to **Device Driver** and confirm that the device's **Connected to Network** is true.
