The purpose of these release notes are to provide detailed information regarding fixes, enhancements, and known issues related to the Luma IP Camera Control System Drivers.

What It Is

These are the Control4 drivers for Luma recorders and IP cameras.

Important Note

Please ensure the sub stream on your control system is set to 6 frames per second or higher. Some control systems treat a stream with lower frame rates as if it were an image.

Features Added

This version fixes bug for zones 10–16 related to alarm events and motion.

Enhanced the driver to dynamically generate the event port.

Added support to enable and disable the following for each channel:

- Send motion email notification
- Send alarm email notification
- Record schedule

Support of H.264 streaming via RTSP on cameras on an external network switch and on the PoE port of the NVR.

Added support for JPEG and MJPEG streaming.

Added support for contact sensor binding so you can link to motion detection events.

Added input trigger notification.

Added support for input trigger binding when the camera contact opens and/or closes.
