

## Purpose

These release notes provide detailed information regarding fixes, enhancements, and known issues related to the Wirepath IP Camera firmware. The firmware versions and their assigned IP cameras are:

1. Wirepath IP Camera version **1.0.20.17**. The following SKUs require this version of firmware:

2. Wirepath IP Camera version **1.0.30.31**. The following SKUs require this version of firmware:
  - WPS-500-PTZ-IP-WH
  - WPS-750-BUL-IP-GR
  - WPS-750-BUL-IP-WH
  - WPS-750-DOM-IP-BL
  - WPS-750-DOM-IP-WH

## New Features/Fixes

Both firmware versions mentioned above have the following fixes:

1. The cameras are now OvrC enabled.
2. Continuous and motion events record when up to three devices (NVRs and/or control systems) access an IP camera using the same login credentials. If a fourth device accesses the same IP camera, the first device loses access to make room for the new device.

## Known Issues

Due to the fixes required to address the above issues, **all settings and configurations are set to factory default values** after upgrading to these versions of firmware. Config files from a previous version are not compatible with these latest versions of firmware. We recommend you write down or take screenshots of your configurations before updating your firmware.
