## THE CONNECTED LOCK FOR A MORE SECURE NEST HOME

The Nest x Yale Lock is a tamper-proof, key-free deadbolt that connects to the Nest app. You can unlock and lock your door from anywhere. Give people you trust a passcode, instead of a key. And always know who comes and goes.<sup>1</sup>

## TOP FEATURES



### No Key Needed

Open your door with your own personal passcode, and assign up to 20 unique ones for others.

No key to lose or risk of having your door lock “bumped” or “picked.”

Nest x Yale Lock will disable its keypad for 90 seconds and send you an alert when someone enters an incorrect passcode five times in a row.



### Remote Control

Nest x Yale Lock can be easily controlled through the Nest app. No need to hide a key. Lock or unlock from anywhere when someone needs to get in.

Set visiting hours for friends, dog walkers or house cleaners. And check your history anytime to see a detailed timeline of who's come in and out over the past 10 days.



### Simple to Install

The Nest x Yale Lock is designed for quick, streamlined installation. It replaces your deadbolt hardware and works with most exterior doors. Most DIY'ers install the lock in 30 min or less. Or if you prefer an expert install, have a Nest Pro install the lock for you.



### Alerts and Notifications

Get alerts in the Nest app when someone accesses your home, when the battery is low, or if someone is tampering with the lock.

Create unique passcodes for family or guests and get notifications when they come and go.

## THOUGHTFUL DESIGN

### Sure Locking

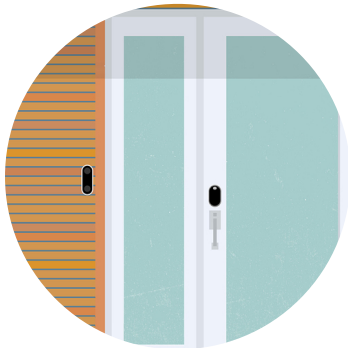
The Nest x Yale Lock can automatically lock itself when no one is home. Auto-Lock automatically engages the lock after a specified amount of time that you set. You'll never have to worry about an unlocked door again.

### No Battery Worries

Get low battery alerts on your phone and see a low battery indicator on the lock itself. However, if the batteries are depleted, you can still unlock the door using a 9V battery by touching it to the bottom of the lock. This will charge up the lock for a one-time entry.

## WHAT THEY'LL LOVE



### For Security

They'll love that the Nest x Yale Lock is built with security in mind. Since it doesn't have a key, it can't be picked or bumped, and it can send them an alert if it's tampered with.

- They won't have to worry about leaving a key under the doormat for anyone to find. They can assign a custom code or unlock the door remotely if someone needs to get in.
- Notifications and history tell them who has been coming and going.
- Home/Away Auto-locking and one-touch on your way out ensures their home will never be left open unintentionally.



### Entertainers and Renters

Nest x Yale Lock will make it easy for customers to share access with friends and family but keep their home safe as well.

- They can assign up to 20 custom codes to share access, and they can set access schedules for each person. It can even send them an alert when someone types in their code.
- 10 day access history lets them see when people have been coming home.
- The app lets them remotely lock and unlock the door to make sure their home is secure after everyone else has gone.

## PRODUCT INTERACTIONS

### Nest Hello

Allows customers to remotely unlock their door when they see a friend (or delivery) through Nest Hello video doorbell.

### Nest Secure

Unlocking the lock will also disarm the Nest Secure alarm system.

### Nest App

Nest x Yale lock can lock automatically when the Nest App knows everyone is away.
